Information on the processing of personal data (GDPR)

Privacy Policy

Protecting your personal data is important to us. In accordance with Art. 13 and 14 GDPR, we inform you below which personal data we process, for what purpose, on what legal basis and by whom, to which recipients it may be disclosed, and which rights you have. The German version of this policy prevails; this English text is for information only.

§ 1 • Controller

The controller within the meaning of the GDPR is the sole proprietorship **I AM THE HUMAN**, owner: Ishak Benammi El Ouahabi, Mammolshainer Straße 40, 60326 Frankfurt am Main, Deutschland. § 2 • Legal Bases

We process personal data on the following legal bases: consent (Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR), performance of a contract or pre-contractual measures (b), compliance with legal obligations (c, e.g. tax/commercial retention), and our legitimate interests (f, e.g. secure and efficient provision of our services).

§ 3 • Your Rights

You have the right of access (Art. 15), rectification (Art. 16), erasure (Art. 17), restriction of processing (Art. 18), data portability (Art. 20) and to object (Art. 21 GDPR).

You may withdraw any consent at any time with effect for the future; an informal notice to the contact in § 1 is sufficient.

§ 4 • Right to Lodge a Complaint

Without prejudice to other remedies, you have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority. § 5 • Contacting Us

If you contact us by email, phone, contact form or via social media (e.g. an Instagram direct message), we process the data you provide to handle your request. The legal basis is Art. 6(1)(b) or (f) GDPR.

§ 6 • Bookings & Membership

To initiate and perform bookings and memberships, we process master and contact data, billing/payment data and order-related information. Identity and client checks (KYC) may require further data. The legal basis is Art. 6(1)(b) and (c) GDPR.

Where specific requests may involve special categories of data (Art. 9 GDPR), we process these only on the basis of your explicit consent.

§ 7 • Disclosure to Providers & Partners

To deliver the service you request, we pass the necessary data to the engaged partners and third-party providers (e.g. jet, yacht, villa, chauffeur, hotel, event or security providers) — only to the extent necessary and for the respective purpose. The legal basis is Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR.

With processors acting on our behalf we conclude data processing agreements under Art. 28 GDPR.

§ 8 • Payment Processing

Clients can pay by bank transfer or via a payment link. For bank transfer, the required data is transmitted to the respective bank; for a payment link, to the payment service provider Revolut (Revolut Bank UAB / Revolut Payments UAB, Konstitucijos ave. 21B, 08130 Vilnius, Lithuania), which processes the data under its own privacy terms. The legal basis is Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR.

§ 9 • Transfers to Third Countries

Our partner network is international. Within the EU/EEA — e.g. France (Côte d'Azur & Saint-Tropez, Paris), Spain (Ibiza, Mallorca, Barcelona), Greece (Mykonos) and Italy — no specific third-country requirements apply.

For services in third countries — in particular the United Arab Emirates (Dubai) and the USA — a transfer outside the EU/EEA may be necessary. This occurs only where necessary for performance of the contract (Art. 49(1)(b) GDPR) or where appropriate safeguards under Art. 44 et seq. GDPR (e.g. EU Standard Contractual Clauses, adequacy decision/EU-US Data Privacy Framework) exist.

§ 10 • Website & Hosting

Our website is hosted by IONOS SE, Elgendorfer Straße 57, 56410 Montabaur, Germany. A data processing agreement under Art. 28 GDPR is in place with IONOS SE.

When you access the website, access data is automatically recorded in server log files (e.g. IP address, date/time, page requested, browser/operating system). Processing serves the secure and stable operation of the website; the legal basis is Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR.

§ 11 • Cookies & Consent

Where non-essential cookies or comparable technologies (e.g. analytics, marketing) are used on our website, this happens only with your prior consent (§ 25(1) TDDDG, Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR). Technically necessary cookies are used on the basis of § 25(2) TDDDG. You may withdraw consent at any time.

§ 12 • Social Media

We maintain profiles on social networks (e.g. Instagram, LinkedIn). If you visit or contact us there, the respective provider processes your data under its own responsibility and privacy terms. For processing via our profiles, Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR applies.

§ 13 • Storage Period

We store personal data only as long as necessary for the respective purposes. Thereafter the data is deleted unless statutory retention obligations (e.g. commercial/tax periods) apply.

§ 14 • Data Security

We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect your data. Transmission via our website is encrypted (TLS/SSL).

§ 15 • Updates

This privacy policy is currently valid. As our services evolve or legal requirements change, it may need to be adapted; the current version published on our website applies.

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
